A RALLYING START FOR THE NEW YEAR

For the Alfa Romeo Owners Club the New Year starts on Sunday, January 22nd with a social rally and lunch organized and hosted by Bob Dewar, the Vice Chairman and Shailesh Chandaria, the Treasurer. The event has been arranged to open the year with a fun outing for members in their Alfas.

The lunch will be held in the upstairs lounge of the Ngong Racecourse after the finish of the rally in the entrance road leading to the main grand stand. The January gathering will enable Club members to exchange news about their year end holidays, buy raffle tickets, discuss the Club's plans for 2017 and hear about the winners of the Victor and Victrix awards.

It is hoped that there will be a strong entry for the social rally which will start from the Total ABC Service Station on Waiyaki Way. Participants should arrive at the start by 9:00 a.m. for morning tea, or coffee, the draw for starting order and the event briefing. The organizers would like to see a strong contingent of Alfa Romeo cars, but there will be a secondary class for members with other makes.

The deadline for entries is Wednesday January 18th and members must register by submitting the enclosed form and the entry fee of 500 shillings per person. This modest charge will help to pay for the prizes.

After the finish of the rally Alfa Romeo cars will be parked in the shade in front of the main Racecourse grand stand and other cars will be placed in the parking area along the road behind the grand stand. The visit to the Racecourse will give members the opportunity to see the impressive growth of the tree which was planted slightly over five years ago to mark the 45th anniversary of the Club and the 100 birthday of Alfa. Equally impressive is the progress of the trees planted in 2016 in the garden of the "Water Front" which is the new Racecourse event site.
